



26' GROWING DOME TOOLS YOU WILL NEED

TOOLS YOU WILL NEED (Unless a Growing Spaces Crew is installing your Dome)*

The following are tools that you will need to have on hand for a self-installation:

Cordless screw gun with reverse function - preferably one for each worker	Pliers
Circular saw with fine tooth blade and crosscut blade	Utility knife
Vice grips / clamps	Carpenters pencil
Magnetic bit holder	Scissors
Hammers - claw hammer, heavy hammer	Caulk gun
7/16" & 1/2" sockets, 9/16" deep socket, and ratchet	Tape measure
Transit, laser or builders' level, and/or 4' level and torpedo level	Handsaw
Wire - or non-stretching string	Adjustable wrench
Felt tip marking pen - thin point	Metal tin snips or aircraft shears
5/16", 3/8" and 1/2" wood bits	Speed square
1/4" magnetic hex driver bit	Shovel
Pry bar/pick/wrecking bar (if ground is really hard)	Stapler
1/4" metal drill bit (required for galvanized sheet metal for pond)	Electric drill

*PROVIDED BY OWNER EVEN IN GROWING SPACES INSTALLATIONS

Rubbing alcohol and clean rags (to clean Glazing prior to taping)

Ladders:

2 - 6' step-ladders

2 - 8' step-ladders or 1 - 6' scaffold section plus planks (optional)

1 - 10' extension ladder (un-extended length)

1 - ladder stabilizer with padded foot covers (for extension ladder)

* Note: Recommended to borrow or rent the ladders instead of purchasing. If crew is flown to the building site, ladders need to be on-site. Ladder quantities may vary depending on how many crew members you have available.
